The Tuscaloosa County Civil Service Board is accepting applications for the position of Maintenance and Facilities Electrician. This is a skilled electrical and maintenance work at the journeyman level.

Responsibilities:

Work involves responsibility for performing skilled electrical tasks on electrical systems and related equipment as well as electronic equipment and devices with skills in computer-related wiring and installation.

Qualifications:

- Current Driver's License
- High school diploma or GED

AND

- Associates degree or certificate in electrical or electronics from an accredited post-secondary college, or completion of an apprenticeship in the trade with considerable experience under a journeyman or master electrician

OR

- Knowledge and experience in the electrical/electronic area with 5 + years training in the field of electricity
- United States Military electrical/electronic certification of 4 + years of documented electrical/electronic training and experience

Salary range: The beginning salary is \$48,450 per year, with annual step raises to \$61,900. Benefits include Alabama State Retirement (Tier 1); Health Insurance \$50/ month single, \$100/month family; 12 paid holidays; and paid leave beginning at 10 days/year and increasing with seniority.
