Commission adjourned; the County Commission met pursuant to such
adjournment with Probate Judge Rob Robertson presiding as Chairman. The

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the minutes of April 5, 2023.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution approving and accepting the preliminary plat submission for Sellers Division, Plat No. 1, District I.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid for the Synergic Center concrete drive to L&D Contracting in the amount of \$45,500.00, the lowest bidder meeting specifications.

Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to allocate District III American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds up to \$59,000.00 and to authorize soliciting RFPs to relocate the waterline in association with the Bear Creek Rd/Old Marion Rd Rebuild Alabama project.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to allocate District III American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds up to \$50,000.00 and to authorize soliciting bids for the waterline relocation project on Delta Dr.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the warrants issued to cover Tuscaloosa County's expenditures for March 2023.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to grant a 60-day request for extension of demolition on 3420 Pinecrest Rd, District II.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to remove 3910 $\frac{1}{2}$ 40th Av NE, District II, from the Public Nuisance/Demolition list.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to fix the cost of demolition and file a lien for such costs on 3902 22nd St NE, District II, and remove the property from the Public Nuisance/Demolition list.
